TWO MINUTES

John 20:19-23 "Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you." And when he said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you withhold the sins of any they are withheld."

The words "Peace be with you" are just as relevant to the fear and dread that occurs in our lives. As Jesus sent his disciples to forgive the sins of people burdened under their sin, the church has ordained Pastors to absolve sins of those who repent and declare them forgiven in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Whatever is bringing fear in our lives, Jesus says "Peace be with you. I am with you always even to the end of the age."

Prayer: Thank you Jesus for forgiving our sins and hearing all our requests. Take our fears and anxieties and help us to trust that you are our refuge and strength and are present in our times of trouble. Amen

Pastor's Column

Today brings us to the end of our "On the wings of an eagle" festival.

Our theme for today is: **SOAR**. ... When do you feel that you can soar? I give a few suggestions in the address today before I speak about a supernatural soaring-flying high- soaring on the wings of an eagle as Isaiah describes it in the passage we have been studying during September (Isaiah 40:28-31) and in particular today's verse 31b: ".*They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint*". We'll be considering what soaring is and what we can do when we soar. I'll be considering an ancient example and one that is much closer to home.

This morning to conclude our festival we have a special morning tea, balloons, as well as the retiring offering for ALWS: as we say: for people who are weary with hunger and sickness.

It is a **shortened service** to cater for those who are setting up for the Fishing Fete.

This evening at **Salt Factory** I shall again be preaching on this topic of Soar.

May you certainly be **refreshed**, **recharged**, **restored**, **revived** as well as renewed by God through our September worship. Yes, may the words of the song- our theme song for the month: "Come live in me, all my life take over, come breathe in me and I will rise on eagles' wings" (which is on our banner) be your prayer throughout this month and... throughout your life.

You might have noticed that we have a **Fellowship Groups' energise meeting** on Wednesday night. This was an outcome of the 40 days of community meeting. A decision was made to "park" the 40 days of community and put our resources/ focus into building the Fellowship / small groups. We'll be working through how to better support groups more, how to support people that may not have ever been in a group before, maybe to assist them work through on what are they looking for in a group, provide guidance such as sharing the workload, have a set time, a group name, resources available, determine baby sitter needs, Bible study guidance and such like. You are welcome to attend.

Next Sunday we shall be celebrating **Lily Braun's baptism** in the morning service.

At that service I shall be preaching on the second reading for the day, in particular Philippians 3:13, 14: Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do know: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.
