TWO MINUTES

With the goal in sight.

What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ (Philippians 3:8)

What do you put your confidence in?

Paul has an impressive list – as we shall hear in the second reading this morning (Philippians 3:14-14) / the Bible reading for Salt Factory. Read it as you are preparing for worship (Verses 4-6 p. 805 TNIV).

Think about it too... what *do* you put your confidence in? That you go to church each week... or each month...or every time there is a baptism? That you live a pretty good life- at least compared to some? Looking at that from a different angle: that you amassed some wealth and you are on a good salary, you are healthy, you have a loving family, you've got (or getting) a good education, you have some dear friends? (Interestingly, all of that can change overnight - as some of us have found.)

Paul found his confidence in Christ and what he had done for him. This not only made everything else pale into insignificance – it made it seem like "garbage" in comparison. Garbage: unhealthy, disease causing stuff that you really don't want to have anything whatsoever to do with.

But think about your list again. Isn't all of this good stuff? Yet any of this can get in the way of your goal in life: knowing Christ. Once you have your goal in sight, you know you are going to win and as Paul goes on to say, you are "straining forward" to take hold of the goal (which I shall be speaking about in the sermon today), then all of this stuff is alright, it is put in its proper place- you see it from a proper perspective.

But first have that goal in sight.

May our worship this morning help you to do just that.

Pastor's Column

Welcome to our worship today. This morning we are celebrating Lily Braun's baptism. A special welcome to Lily's parents: Chloe and Jeff and her godparents Philip and Sharna. The Braun's have been worshipping with us over the last month and I pray they feel comfortable enough with us to get more involved.

Today, I am preaching on the second reading for the day, in particular Philippians 3:13, 14: Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus. The Theme is "Finish well". Like Lily, we started well at our baptism- because that was God's act of claiming us, making a promise to us, establishing a close relationship that we can always go back to. But how do we finish? Paul gives an image for all time reaching forward like a runner, forgetting what is behind and having that one goal in mind- to finish well. I am looking forward to exploring that image with you today.

Thanks to all those who set up, ran, served and came along to our Annual Fishing Fete, especially Daryl, Graeme, Ian, Michael and Geoff and others on the GGAF committee. It was a wonderful day. Please see elsewhere about what came out of the day.

This past week we had some interesting meetings: the Board meeting where we concentrated on the future of GGLF. I reckon there will be some significant proposals at our Half Yearly meeting (27/11/11), Pastors' conference: The highlight is always catching up with fellow pastors but the presentation of "Biblical basis for preaching", better use of powerpoint in worship, "Let's talk about mission" workshop by our mission director and the electives on "Word and Prayer' and Youth Ministry were also useful. The Fellowship Groups energise 4 Life meeting came up with a proposal to invite our mission director, Steen Olsen to give a presentation on Small Groups on a Sunday morning. More information about this when it comes to hand.

During the week of 16th October you will be asked to fill in the National Church Life Survey. This is a census across all churches and has in the past given some valuable information. It takes 15-20 minutes to complete and you will be asked to do it when you attend worship or any other meetings that week.

Please note on 6th November we will be having a discussion at the Salt Factory worship on Where are we going with Salt Factory in 2012? Please plan to be there and to contribute to the discussion.

I am thinking of running a Bethel Bible Study course in 2012 and 2013. Bethel is a course that gives an overview of the whole Bible. It takes about 2 years to complete. It will cost \$20 a term. (Each term is "stand alone".) I will only be running it if I get enough interest and commitment. For more information on Bethel look it up on the web.
