TWO MINUTES

IS THIS YOUR NEW LIFE?

ABC personality Caroline Jones writes (c.1993) on what it meant for her to become a Christian:

"What does this new life of faith feel like? It's difficult to be fluent in a newly learned language. It feels like coming to a strange land, a new culture... It is like remembering something long forgotten... It's accepting a healing mystery effortlessly and with gratitude, and feeling no need to probe its heart. It is having new eyes to see colours more vividly; new ears to hear harmony. It is being slowed down, drawn to gaze at the intricacy and perfection of nature as if for the first time. It does not banish hurts, crises or loneliness. I approach these problems in a new way, panicking less, trusting more that things will unfold, maybe unexpectedly, but with a purpose. Life is more peaceful at some deep level even below trouble on the surface. It is like sighing deeply. It is like you feel after crying. It is a new ability to see what is wrong with me, or some of that; to acknowledge it, to get on with making a loaf of bread anyway. It's like a marvellous joke of which I've only just got the point. It's like time-lapse photography in which I actually see the rosebud unfolding. It's like a child's treasure hunt in which I wait with excitement for the next discovery. It feels as though stones have been lifted from my heart, and knots untied in my stomach. It feels as though there are answers, even though I can't remember them all.... It is a feeling of well-being much of the time.... To sense more readily the difference between love and what is not love, between good and what is not good. It is the unexpected relief of the prodigal forgiven and loved in spite of all. It's like coming off a battlefield and finding a family of common hopes and destiny."

Pastor's Column

We welcome **Ethan David Ennis** into our membership through Holy Baptism this morning. Ethan is the son of Dave & Jacqui and Ethan's godparents are Shaun and Lauren Copeland and Chris, Jessica and Tyler Ennis.

On the Reformation Day (and any other day for that matter) it's good to remember what Martin Luther had to say about Baptism. What is Baptism? A. Baptism is not water only, but it is water used together with God's Word and by his command. What is this Word? In Matthew 28 our Lord Jesus Christ says: ``Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and of the Holy Spirit." What benefits does God give in Baptism? In baptism God forgives sin, delivers from death and the devil, and gives everlasting salvation to all who believe what He has promised. What is God's promise? In Mark 16 our Lord Jesus Christ says: ``He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned."

This morning in the address we are looking for the answer to the question. "What does it mean to you that you are a Lutheran"? We are going to use history and geography to explore that question. It has a lot to do with freedom that comes from the Truth- Jesus himself as he reveals himself through the Word and Sacrament. The address is based on the Gospel reading for today, from John 8 in particular verse 31, 32"... To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

We are also holding the **Longest Lutheran Lunch**, today. Please join us at Golden Grove and Lutherans all around Australia and New Zealand as we sit down at tables throughout Australasia to make up this longest Lutheran lunch . You can see (elsewhere in this Bulletin) that for your \$10 (under 15, \$5) you are getting a most sumptuous lunch. 
