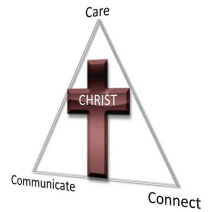

TWO MINUTES

I was hungry and you fed me

I was hungry and you fed me, thirsty and you gave me a drink; I was a stranger and you received me in your homes, naked and you clothed me; I was sick and you took care of me, in prison and you visited me... I tell you, whenever you did this for one of the least important of these brothers of mine, you did it for me! Matt 25: 35-36, 40

At our staff Bible study the other night we discussed social justice. We discussed what social justice is and we questioned who is responsible. We talked about what we can achieve socially, politically, and we asked what we can do in our workplaces, in our classrooms. Jesus makes the answer pretty clear in the above verses. He's not talking simply about the 'rules' of polite hospitality. He's challenging us to action and calling each of us to tackle issues of poverty and powerlessness. So how can I make a difference? From standing up for the rights of the victim against the bully, to prayer; from writing letters to our Members of Parliament, to giving of our money to aid agencies like ALWS; from volunteering of our time, to showing kindness – we can make a difference!

Dear God, Move me to make a difference in my home, my work, my community and in my society, showing your love to those around me.
