### And He shall reign for ever and ever - Hallelujah!

I love to watch the Carols by Candlelight, from the Sidney Myer Music Bowl in Melbourne, each year on Christmas Eve. The sound of the massed choirs singing the Hallelujah Chorus, stops people and gets their attention to the real meaning of Christmas. Even though they have been singing the various of versions of traditional carols, their meaning can get lost in the performance by the celebrity. However with the repetition of 'He shall reign for ever and ever' and 'King of Kings and Lord of Lords', you cannot miss who they're singing about.

In David's time, this enduring reign was foretold, as we hear in the Old Testament reading: "Your throne shall be established forever."

Paul reminds us about the revelation of the mystery of Jesus Christ, the promised Messiah, and his purpose of bringing salvation to ALL who have faith. Even those who just go the 'Carols' to see their favourite celebrity, yet also hear about God's promise through the words of each carol.

Our Gospel mirrors the words of the massed choirs: "He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, and he will reign over the house of Jacob for ever; his kingdom will never end."

As you watch them on television, listen to them while you finish your last minute shopping, and sing them in church, may the meaning of the words of the carols resound for you — that Jesus' reign still goes on, and will go on for ever and ever.

### Pastor's Column

Have you ever thought: Why do I obey? – Why am I doing what I am told? Interesting question- often children are asked the opposite "Why are you being so disobedient?" But often parents or teachers who are asking that aren't expecting an answer – at least not a respectful one.

This opens a concept that the second reading (Romans 16:25-27) this morning denotes: **Obedience that comes from faith.** We'll consider what this obedience is, how does it change our lives and again why do we obey with this obedience that comes from faith?

Tonight in the Salt Factory time slot we are holding our "dress rehearsal' for our Christmas Eve drama "For God so loved the world- Christmas 2011." Why not come along to this to see how good it is so that you have that confidence and encouragement to invite your neighbours and friends to come with you to the drama on Christmas Eve? Remember the drama on Christmas Eve starts at 7pm.

Next Sunday is Christmas Day. In that service we have the opportunity to contemplate (like Mary) the wonder of wonders: God come in the flesh. This really defines who our God is.


