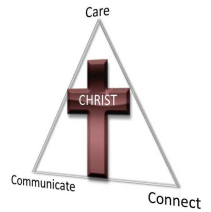

TWO MINUTES

Pastor's Column

Today we are celebrating our **Thanksgiving Service**. The theme for this year's thanksgiving service is "*Thank God for Family and Friends*". My address is entitled: "**Why thank God for family and friends?**" It seems like the right thing to do but for just what do we thank God? We are going to look at **5 pictures of families** in the Bible in the address: Abraham's, Job's, David's, Joseph's and Jesus' family to help us think more deeply about our thanks.

Did you attend our inaugural session of *our new Bible study class*, entitled **LOGOS**? Wasn't there a lot of great material in the presentation? Why don't you come along to today's session? We are looking at God and creation. This course will be run most Sundays, from 11am-12.30pm (*See the dates on the flyer in the foyer.*) Anthony Power is leading it and I will be in attendance. *Come along and grow.*

This afternoon (at a 2.30pm service in our church building) **Alex Gregorovich** is receiving God's grace through Holy Baptism. This is outside our regular service times for medical reasons. Please pray for Alex, his family and friends and his support family Ron and Candy Fry.

Please join us for the commencement of Lent with our **Ash Wednesday worship** *this Wednesday*. The service will include Holy Communion and "*the imposition of ashes*".

On the following Wednesdays in Lent we shall be holding a half hour devotion. In these devotions we shall be walking with Jesus on his way to the cross through the passion narrative, singing a couple of traditional hymns, praying and discussing the Psalm for the day, according to **The One Year Bible** (*see the reading plan in each week's Bulletin.*) We will be holding these devotions before "*the side altar*" in our worship centre and using the organ. The side altar is furnished with crucifix, candles and frontal from the chapel (which has been de-consecrated to make room for the uniform shop.)

Don't forget about **THE GATHERING**, in 2 weeks time: Saturday 27th February at Schmocker's block (where we have held the last 4). Come along to this time of worship, discussion and retreat. *You are all welcome.* Please bring a chair, morning tea and salad/ desert to share and a few of dollars towards the meat for BBQ lunch.

Many who are suffering for their faith in Jesus don't ask for the persecution to stop, they simply plead: "Pray for us, and please send Bibles." Next Sunday our congregation will begin: **Bibles for persecuted Christians**, a 21 days program which will focus special attention on our courageous persecuted brothers and sisters in Christ. You will be offered "A Light in the Dark" prayer resource booklet and a Bible shaped money box. *See the poster in our foyer.*

We are running a **Step Up to Communion** course starting on 7th March. *See information on this elsewhere in this Bulletin.* If you are in year 5 and above at school talk to your parents about it and if they agree that you are ready for communion, come along. Also tell others. I would hate people to miss out on finding out more about Holy Communion and being "admitted to the Sacrament".

Also with **Confirmation Day** looming up: 28th February, we are starting **another group** for people who would like to be confirmed in their faith. It will be called "**Journey**".

**Learning Assistance Programme – LAP at
GGLPS**

- LAP – a special programme for students who would benefit from individual time with a caring volunteer.
 - Parents, or volunteers from the community, come to the school and work with a particular student who has been identified as needing support.
 - Students participate in a variety of experiences depending upon individual needs.
- Special emphasis is placed on developing close, positive relationships between the students and the volunteer to assist in building self-esteem and confidence.

Who are the volunteers?

The volunteer may be a parent, grand-parent, old scholar or interested community member. They become a friend and mentor for the student and participate and share in the challenge and excitement of a student's learning.

Volunteers have the opportunity to communicate a sense of value, friendship and personal worth to help their student feel special.
