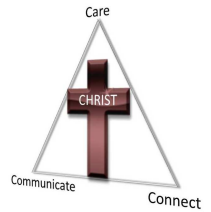

Pastor's Appraisal

This year marks Pastor Leon's 3 year anniversary with GGLF so we have been asked to arrange an appraisal of his ministry at GGLF in line with LCA guidelines. The process also allows Pastor Leon to complete an appraisal of GGLF as a congregation.

Pastors will never be able to do perfectly everything that is expected of a pastor; they are always going to be stronger in some areas and a little weaker in others, hence the appraisal to allow them to grow in relevant areas.

Approximately a fifth of our members will be asked to participate and they have been selected to ensure there is a reasonable representation of the congregation with regard to: male/female; married/single; family structures; age ranges; involvement in various groups/activities; etc.

Responses will be received anonymously and collated before being presented to Pastor Leon. If you are asked to complete the appraisal we ask that you do so prayerfully, carefully, honestly, and sensitively so that Pastor Leon can receive a realistic, honest and sensitive appraisal of his ministry here at GGLF.

When the appraisal process has been completed the results will be reported to the congregation.
