

TWO MINUTES

Our names are written in heaven.

However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in the heaven." Luke 10:20

The seventy two had just come back from their mission trip and they were justifiably excited. They had healed the sick and could report: "Lord even the demons submit to us in your name" (verse 17). They had trusted Jesus and he came through, again.

But Jesus had to remind them that there is something deeper which they could rejoice over: that they had a place in heaven/ they belonged to God/ God loved them and they were special to him.

I too get excited about the things I see God doing through us in Jesus' name. Really, there is nothing wrong with that. We trust in Jesus and he comes through. But what is more important is who we are or whose we are- what he has done for us in writing our names in heaven.

Today we are starting the third part of our series "Grow in faith"- through the community. Like the seventy two we are a community through which God works. But what is more important than the things God does through us is what God gives us: that close relationship with him, which he strengthens and revitalizes this morning as we gather in his name.

Prayer: Thank you, Lord for all that you are doing through us. Thank you too, for what you are giving us – that our names are written in heaven- so who we are in you: a community of believers. Give us a deeper faith that we may base our joy more on what we believe than what we see or experience. Amen. **Pastor Leon**

Pastor's Column

Today we begin the next step of our series: Grow in Faith with Grow in faith in the community. The text I have chosen is that beautiful description of the community in the early church (from Acts 2:42-47) They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. All the believers were together and had everything in common. They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved. We'll be considering how our spiritual community is: Sacramental: based on Baptism, nourished through Holy Communion, Church - fellowship and an expression of servanthood, a place of forgiveness, hope and worship. All of these are expressions of faith and through which we grow in our faith.

Next Sunday our ALC student, James Leach will be leading the service. The address for that week is based on **Matthew 6:24-34.** How do you handle worry?

During this series we have a **special focus each month**. In **May** it was telling us "your spiritual habits" in regard to Bible reading; in **June** it was "how God has answered your prayers" and now in **July** our foci are the Day Pay Challenge which we are launching on the last Sunday of the month and the Prayer Vigil on the last day of the month.

Speaking about the **Prayer Vigil.** It is 24 hours where our church building will be open (supervised of course) and you are encouraged to come and spend at least a half an hour in prayer for the life of the congregation. The Worship Centre, Prayer Garden, Fellowship Centre and Fellowship Lounge have been set aside for this purpose. There will be resources available and most times there will be people to pray with if you don't like to pray on your own. Put your name down on the schedule now.

I shall be away for 2 weeks annual leave. This is part of the annual leave that I didn't take in 2008.


Car park Capers
