Sorry...

In our readings today there appear to be a few reasons to say "Sorry".

God gave the Israelites opportunity after opportunity to say "sorry" and turn back to His ways. He never gave up on them. "No-one will take her out of my hands." says the Lord. Each time they strayed, they were punished. Each time God took them back.

The people of Colossae were reminded that each time they sinned, these sins were taken away by the forgiveness they received through their baptism, and the faith they were taught. By saying "Sorry" they could seek God's forgiveness and His triumph over the cross.

And what's the best way to say "Sorry" to God – through the prayer He taught us in the Gospel. Through this simple prayer we acknowledge God as Lord, thank Him for all He gives us, and ask for His forgiveness for the all wrong we have done.

Pastor's Column

We welcome Jodi Wilson and family and friends joining us for **Ciara Lee Wilson's Baptism** this morning.

Today we shall be looking at the Gospel reading for the day: Luke 11:1-13. The theme for this morning's meditation is Give as children: Give because you have a great example. It's the direct approach. I think of the Father in this respect. Give because you really don't like the alternative. Our approach can be quite *shameless*. Jesus is the example. Give because you want to. We just trust. And this is the fruit of the Holy Spirit.

This morning we are also launching our **Day Pay Challenge**. Here are some points to keep in mind.

- It is a good habit of weekly giving to God (to tithe) as a constant way of saying thanks to God, like saying grace before a meal, but every so often we need to express our gratitude in a more substantial way and that is what Day's Pay Challenge is all about.
- Simply the *Day's Pay Challenge* is to give how much you earn in one day. One way of calculating this is by taking your annual salary (either gross or net) and dividing it by 200. Of course if your work is sporadic or part time or casual it is a bit more complicated. But the 200 rule on gross makes it simple. So if you earn \$30,000 a year, it would be \$150; \$50,000 it would be \$250; for "the average Australian pay" of \$67, 070 it would be about \$335. If you receive the single aged pension it would be about \$45; if you work in a café, for \$890 a week it would be about \$110; if you receive \$10 pocket money a week it would be \$2.
- Please use the envelopes marked Servant September Day Pay Donation and place it in the offering plate by 29th August in 6 week's time. If you want to do it through REG, just put a note in the envelope indicating this.
- This is your challenge. It is between you and God- an expression of thanks to God and it's a means to give a boost to our congregation.

I am very excited that this Saturday we are holding our **Prayer Vigil** for the *Life of the congregation*. Please note the details about the Prayer Vigil elsewhere in this Bulle tip
