Here are some points I made in regard to the **DAY PAY CHALLENGE**

- It is good habit to weekly giving to God (to tithe) as a constant way of saying thanks to God, like saying grace before a meal, but every so often we need to express our gratitude in a more substantial way and that is what Day's Pay Challenge is all about.
- Simply the *Day's Pay Challenge* is to give how much you earn in one day. One way of calculating this is by talking your annual salary (either gross or net) and dividing it by 200. Of course if your work is sporadic or part time or casual it is a bit more complicated. But the 200 rule on gross makes it simple. So if you earn \$30,000 a year, it would be \$150; \$50,000 it would be \$250; for "the average Australian pay" of \$67, 070 it would be about \$335. If you receive the single aged pension it would be about \$45; if you work in a café, for \$890 a week it would be about \$110; if you receive \$10 pocket money a week it would be \$2.
- Please use the envelopes marked Servant September Day Pay Donation and place it in the offering plate by 29th August. If you want to do it through REG, just put a note in the envelope indicating this.
- This is your challenge. It is between you and God an expression of thanks to God and it's a means to give a boost to our congregation.


