Move Up

But when you are invited take the lowest place so that when your host comes, he will say to you 'Friend, move up to a better place.' Then you will be honoured in the presence of all the other guests (Luke 14:10)

You know the situation well. You have the opportunity to take the advantage and... you take it. Like Mary Bale: a cat next to a wheelie binwhat do you do? (In bad taste, I know.) The people arriving earlier to the party took the places of honour. It is so very natural. I like to sit next to the host at a party. Just like all you people who got here early so that you could sit in the front rows (or is it in the back rows!) in the Worship Centre this morning.

But what happens when you get caught- be it the security camera, or when the pastor walks in?

In the situation Jesus was experiencing it was when the host walked in. It's then he will re-arrange the seating.

Of course Jesus is not just thinking about the wisest thing to do when you go to a party. He is thinking about life - as he puts it elsewhere – the kingdom of God. Be humble now and God will elevate you when you come face to face with Him. I am looking forward to Jesus saying to me 'Friend, move up to a better place.' This is not to manipulate God. This is to be like Jesus in this life, to have the Holy Spirit who produces humility, moving in our heart-. It's to accept the position we find ourselves in.

But the wonderful thing about worship is that God honours us now. Move up: to a place of honour in remembering who you are through Baptism. Move up: when you hear God speaking personally to you through his Word. Move up: as you stand to receive Holy Communion before the Altar. This is the "better place" because this is when your host Jesus himself ministers to you and elevates you to a place of honour. You are being honoured in the presence of all the other guests - and dear friends, this includes the angels in heaven!

Prayer: Thank you Lord that you invite us to move up to a better place- close to you. Forgive us when we have fallen into the ways of the world and wanted their places of honour. Please help us, when we find ourselves in humble circumstances to remember that here we are close to you. Amen Pastor Leon

DAY PAY CHALLENGE

- It is a good habit of weekly giving to God (to tithe) as a constant way of saying thanks to God, like saying grace before a meal, but every so often we need to express our gratitude in a more substantial way and that is what *Day's Pay Challenge* is all about.
- Simply the *Day's Pay Challenge* is to give how much you earn in one day. One way of calculating this is by talking your annual salary (either gross or net) and dividing it by 200. Of course if your work is sporadic or part time or casual it is a bit more complicated. But the 200 rule on gross makes it simple. So if you earn \$30,000 a year, it would be \$150; \$50,000 it would be \$250; for "the average Australian pay" of \$67, 070 it would be about \$335. If you receive the single aged pension it would be about \$45; if you work in a café, for \$890 a week it would be about \$110; if you receive \$10 pocket money a week it would be \$2.
- Please use the envelopes marked *Day Pay Challenge Donation* and place it in the offering plate. If you want to do it through REG, just put a note in the envelope indicating this.
- This is your challenge. It is between you and God an expression of thanks to God and it's a means to give a boost to our congregation.

Welcome to our visitors today. We hope the visiting children enjoy their time at Golden Grove today. Parents please note the information on the front page of the bulletin about "family friendly worship". There are also some puzzles, word games and activities for older children in the children's area (on top of the storage unit).

Thanks to Emi for running the activity for the <u>Kids Quiet Craft</u> table this week. The children can go to the craft table with or without their parents, after the children's address. (There are usually a few helpers available to guide the pre-schoolers.) The craft activity will last for the duration of Pastor's message. If any children remain at the craft table after this time, they are required to stay quiet, and to help with packing up. :-).

The aim of the craft program is to help the children visualise and interpret God's message in a tactile and fun way, to take their article home and to talk about it with their families, thereby assimilating the message into their hearts and heads. We often find that the busier the hands, the quieter the lips, but if we have large numbers today, we would ask the parents to be reinforcements when required! On the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month, we have a special " <u>Kids at Heart time</u> for our little ones in another area. The <u>Goal</u> is to Share the love of Jesus with songs, stories, games and <u>more!</u>



- Donations of fibrefill, for stuffing the wreaths.


