Mark 10: 14... "Let the little children come to me"

Thanks to Meg Ahrens for running the activity for the <u>Kids</u> <u>Quiet Craft</u> table this week. The children can go to the craft table with or without their parents, after the children's address. (There are usually a few helpers available to guide the pre-schoolers.) The craft activity will last for the duration of Pastor's message. If any children remain at the craft table after this time, they are required to stay quiet, and to help with packing up.

The aim of the craft program is to help the children visualise and interpret God's message in a tactile and fun way, to take their article home and to talk about it with their families, thereby assimilating the message into their hearts and heads. We often find that the busier the hands, the quieter the lips, but if we have large numbers today, we would ask the parents to be reinforcements when required!
