### Mark 15:33 - 39

In verse 39 we read "And when the centurion, who stood there in front of Jesus, heard his cry and saw how he died, he said "Surely this man was the Son of God!"

The centurion was surely touched by the Spirit of God as he witnessed Jesus's death and responded outwardly with a concerned comment that "Surely this man was the Son of God!"

We also have God's Spirit working within us, but are we outwardly commenting to the people around us, that Jesus is the Son of God? We are often fooled by satan that if we speak out, confessing in public that we believe Jesus is the Son of God, that we will be rejected or ridiculed or taken as a fool. But as we know the truth, we have nothing to be afraid of. In fact it is a real blessing to be questioned about our faith in Jesus, so we can learn and grow from that experience to trust in God even more, who will then through the power of His Holy Spirit strengthen you to stand firm in the faith.




