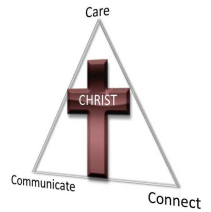

TWO MINUTES

In the reading from Colossians this week, we read about the supremacy of Christ, the image of the invisible God, who created all things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible. All authorities, powers and thrones are created by him. He is before and above all things and in him, all things hold together. Nothing can defeat him. On November 11 at 11 am, many of us took the opportunity to stand for one minute in silence to remember the war dead of many nations in the two World Wars and the wars that have happened since, or are, indeed still happening. Those sombre words "Lest we forget" rang out at the many memorial services being held all over the world. I have many reasons to be thankful to all those who served and died so that I could continue on with my life. However, while Nov 11 will always be "Remembrance Day", every day of our lives is a day to remember that God gave his only son, Jesus Christ to be killed on the cross for you and me, so that our sins may be forgiven and that we may look forward to eternal life with him! NANNY WANTED

A young family from our congregation, living at Golden Grove, are looking for a nanny for their three children, ages 6, 3 and 2.

The hours and days vary each week and are spread over a six week rotating roster. In the six weeks, the hours will total approx 73, an average of about 24 hrs a fortnight. Some cleaning and housekeeping is required and school drop offs and pick ups also. The pay is \$18 / hr, which averages out to approx \$438 a fortnight, or a total of around \$1300 over the six week period.
