In Matthew 24: 36-48 today we read about something not discussed that often in Lutheran circles, 'the Rapture'. As it says in 1 Corinthians 15; we'll be changed in an instant, in the blink of an eye. The Bible describes Jesus in many ways, but arguably none quite as challenging as in the Gospel reading for today, in particular these verses: <sup>42</sup> "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come. <sup>43</sup> But understand this: If the owner of the house had known at what time of night the thief was coming, he would have kept watch and would not have let his house be broken into. <sup>44</sup> So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him- "Jesus: like a thief." This is what we shall consider today through the three ways we can get ready for a thief. Can you think of what they would be?
