

Pastor's Column

How do you feel at this time of the year? Would it be good to take to heart God's Word: **Be still and know that I am God**. I am going to take up 3 points from this verse (in which our theme is taken: Psalm 46:10): Be still to focus, be still to be open and be still to grow.

Thanks to Susanne Trigg for the banners above the Altar on this theme: Be still and know that I am God.

Over Christmas I am going to explore that word "**to know**": Just what does it mean to know, how can we know and what deepens our knowing.

We were going to have a special carols service on the day after Christmas but with the success of last week's worship "Christmas is coming, let's celebrate", we'll be using a standard order of service (of course with a lot of carols) so as to continue the theme of knowing.

The importance of keeping to "Child Safe" practices has been brought to my attention. A three day REV320 event in January has had to be cancelled because 'Permission to Proceed' documentation was not put in place.

At this time of the year many people are **hurting**. If there is something in particular that you are finding it hard to come to grips with, we are able to put you in contact with counsellors. Please see Pastor Leon for details.

You may have got wind that C.S Lewis' "The Chronicles of Narnia: the voyage of the Dawn Treader" is now in cinemas. I encourage you to see this movie. It has a strong Christian message and so it's a great evangelism tool. I saw it last week and can highly recommend it — especially in 3D!

How are you going in your Care, Communicate and Connect so that people know Christ? Last Sunday I spoke on encouraging others to celebrate Christmas. I said that we do this by 1) Praying for people: we pray God acts - why then wouldn't we pray and continue to pray for people? 2) We study- get to know the Christmas story deeper, in how it is for 2010, through literature – and our church library has many books and a few DVDs for this, and 3) Through our giving and thanksgiving which prompts people to ask why we are doing that. Isn't this precisely our vision to care, communicate and connect? Just how are you going to do that this Christmas?

PLEASE NOTE: There will be NO Salt Factory catering through to end of January 2011 due to school holidays.

Update from half yearly meeting of GGLF held on Sunday 28 November 2010.

The meeting considered our financial situation to the end of October which showed an expected end of year budget shortfall of about \$20,000. The Management Team had proposed that unless substantial further donations were received we would need to reduce our loan repayments for 2010 and the hours for our Church Office Secretary and Youth Team Leader for 2011 to provide a balanced budget.

At the meeting it was announced that following the release of the proposal a \$10,000 donation was received and at the meeting members pledged a further \$17,650 to be paid before the end of December 2010 to allow us to pay all of our 2010 expenses and end the year with a budget surplus. Also the members present voted to amend the budget for 2011 to keep current staff levels and to increase our offerings/donation for 2011 by the necessary amount to match our expenditure. A revised budget will presented at our AGM in May 2011 with extra information to be provided in early 2011.

The meeting recommended that all members consider their level of regular giving so that we can avoid our usual end of year budget pleas.

For those who made a pledge of support and those who did not have the chance but wish to also donate to support our 2010 budget you can either place your pledged amount (cash or cheque payable to Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship) in the weekly offering, send a cheque to our Church Office (PO Box 1371 Golden Grove SA 5125), or arrange a bank transfer to our LLL account (BSB 704942 Account 28190).

For those members who use REG we invite you to review your level of giving and for those not yet using REG we invite you to take up this option to support the budget of our Church and the work or our Lord (forms are available in the Church foyer).

On a personal note, I was so pleased to see the commitment of our members to make sure we meet our commitments to our staff and loans for both this year and into the future. Thank you so much to all who provided the passionate discussion and support for our continued work at Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship.
