

Our theme over these last few weeks has been: **Be still and know** that I am God (from Psalm 46:10). A couple of weeks ago (12/12/10), we looked at how we can **be still** at this time of the year (the sermon is on our web page, as are all sermons) and now we are considering how can we know. On Christmas Day we are going to look at how **Mary knew** and on the Sunday after Christmas (26/12/10) we are considering how **Joseph** knew.

Thanks to all those who were involved in the Christmas play this year, "**People of the Christmas story**" especially to Lauren Thiel who directed it. It was a great effort.

At this time of the year many people are **hurting**. If there is something in particular that you are finding it hard to come to grips with, we are able to put you in contact with counsellors. Please see Pastor Leon for details.

Are you wondering what we are doing for **New Year's Eve** this year? If you are I am happy to inform you that Jon & Jacqui Schutz and family have kindly offered their backyard (and swimming pool) for New Year's Eve service and fellowship this year. *(Please see mud map elsewhere in this bulletin for directions to Schutz's home.)* We are celebrating a "Fiji New year's Eve": ie. we are going to note the New Year when it hits Fiji, which is 9.30pm our time – then we don't have to have such a late night. **It starts at 7.30pm with worship**. So you are invited to wear your loud Hawaiian shirts, bathers, grass skirts... bring drinks chairs and nibbles, celebrate the past year and look forward to the new with worship and stick around for an hour of so to welcome in the (Fiji) new year. Join us.

We enter the New Year as a congregation with **Care**, **Communicate and Connect so that people know Christ** as our vision and goal.

In lieu of our 6.30 pm service a DVD series will be run.


Judith taking LSL
