**TWO MINUTES**

A Position of Weakness (Ezekiel 2:1-5; 2 Cor.12:2-10; Mark 6: 1-13)

Ezekiel fell face down on the ground. I wondered what made him do that, so I read Ezekiel Chapter 2 from verse 1. Wow! What a vision he had. No wonder he fell down. As I read on I saw that God filled him with His spirit and gave him the words to speak (unusually, by getting him to eat the scroll!), all the while calling him 'weak' mortal man (The Good News version).

We hear about Paul, the mortal man, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 12: 2-10 reading also, with his afflictions that God wouldn't take away. Instead Paul proclaims he is weak so that the Lord could be strong in him.

Jesus disciples were also given the power of the Lord to heal and drive out demons, and in the same breath were told not to take anything with them on their mission but rather to rely on others to provide. What a position of weakness. Every day we're reminded of our own weakness, our mortality and we could easily wonder what is to become of us. However we need not worry. Through the grace of God we can have the power of our Lord Jesus Christ in us, just like Ezekiel, Paul and the disciples. Our weakness becomes our strength when we trust in God and His promises!

*Pray with me: Lord, when I'm feeling weak, help me remember that Your Holy Spirit is with me, making me strong. Amen.*
