E-LIBRARY SET UP

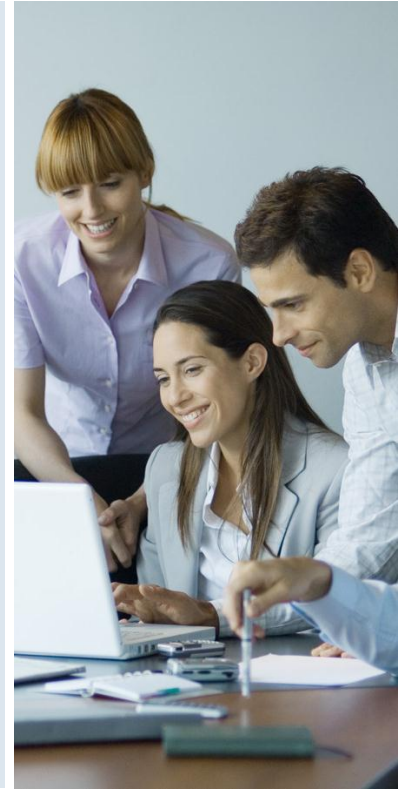
